<input type="checkbox"/> <u>If you arrive before your designated move-in date</u> , apply for iMED Date Change Request directly to David Cummings Insurance Services. Apply as soon as you know your arrival date in Canada and after you have received your iMED card.	The form can be found here , and please also attach a picture of your boarding pass or stamp on your passport to prove your actual arrival date to Canada.
